

Hector St. John de Crevecoeur Orange County Farmer Visionary of the Revolutionary Era

To celebrate National archives week, The Chester Historical Society will host Town of Warwick historian and author Dr. Richard Hull and rare book merchant Rodger Friedman who will will speak on Hector St. John deCrevecoeur.

Crevecoeur, of Blooming Grove/Chester, Orange County Farmer and Visionary of the Revolutionary Era, wrote "Letters of an American Farmer" (1782) a volume of essay-length letters which informed readers about life in the early American republic. The original de Crevecoeur deed and other local documents will be displayed.
